Kaya is a global learning platform where learners will find both online and in-person learning opportunities, which are completely free to access.

Reaching over **700,000** humanitarians across the world, a high concentration of learners are from countries facing access issues to training. Kaya has over **500** free courses available in up to 12 languages to help learners improve their understanding of humanitarian responses.

Learning content is also available from our partners including UN agencies, the International Rescue Committee, and the International Committee of the Red Cross.

Kaya serves hard-to-reach humanitarian learners as it can be used without internet connection.
